Thank you for considering giving to St John's by Standing Order. You should find it a very easy and efficient method of giving and for the church it means we have a better idea of what our income will be from month to month.

To set up a standing order you just have to give your bank our sort code (16-32-10) and account number (13434558) then tell them how much you want to transfer and how frequently. The form opposite is included for your convenience, if you use it you should send it directly to your bank. If you have a joint account make sure the form is signed by all the people named on the account.

If you use your bank online you may be asked for a reference, please use your surname and initials.

You can amend your standing order at any time by writing to your bank (or using your online banking facility). You do not have to tell us in advance about the amendment but it would help us if you do so that we can keep our spending budget up to date.

giftaid it

If you are a taxpayer please make a Gift Aid declaration so that we can claim back the tax you paid on your gift from HM Revenue & Customs.

For every £1 you give we can claim back 28p (at current tax rates). See Norman Hope for a declaration form.
